

Denver Public Library Security Camera Policy

The Denver Public Library strives to maintain a safe and secure environment for its patrons, staff, and property. The library's security system includes cameras in public areas.

Signs to inform patrons about the cameras are posted at the south and east entrances to the library building.

Images from the library's security cameras are stored in the library digitally on hardware. The library retains recorded images for a limited period of time.

The images are administrative records to be viewed only at the discretion of the Library Director or other authorized persons.

In no instances shall security camera footage be used for the purpose of, or clearing to attempts to determine what materials have been checked out by any patron, reviewed by any patron other than in cases of allegations of theft from the library, or pursuant to a court order.
